
#### **REPORT**



## AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON CONSERVATION OF WATER BODIES

Programme Type: Awareness Programme on 'Conservation of Water Bodies' Semester: 6<sup>th</sup> semester *Duration: One Day* Date: 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 Venue: Dal Lake Organisers: NSS & Eco Club No of Students: 35

#### **REPORT**

A group of 35 NSS volunteers along with faculty members were taken to world famous Dal Lake for awareness programme with regard to conservation of water bodies. The NSS Officers accompanied the volunteers to the selected site for the programme to kickstart. The aim of this programme was to highlight the importance of water bodies for the sustainable development, the current status of deterioration and future planning for the conservation. After reaching Dal Lake, students were given basic information about Dal Lake, such as its morphometry, its topography and current status of physicochemical features. The NSS officers further explained the historical importance of Dal Lake and the current socio-economic importance. The students were apprised of different factors which emerged in the last four decades that were responsible for the deterioration of environmental quality of Dal Lake. After the brief description about the Dal Lake, students were shown different basins of the lake and the areas which are currently showing altered ecological conditions. The NSS volunteers also participated in the cleanliness drive in and around foreshore area of Dal Lake.
