



Dr. Ummer Zargar, Assistant Professor Zoology also a delivered a detailed talk on this years theme "Take the Right Path". The concluding remarks was presented by Dr. Malik Yasir, in which he emphasized the need for cohesive mechanism to deal with fast spread of HIV/AIDS among adolescents and impressed upon the students
