Session I

The inaugural session commenced in the conference hall at 11:30 AM with a presidential address by the esteemed Principal, Prof. Peer Irfan Ahmad. In his address, Prof. Ahmad emphasized the importance of recognizing the role of women across various sectors and urged the audience to work towards the upliftment of women. The keynote speech was delivered by Ms. Aarizoo Javaid, MUNSIF/JMIC Dooru. In her address, she outlined the aims and objectives of celebrating International Women's Day and discussed the significant contributions of women to the overall growth and development of the country. Ms. Javaid highlighted the necessity of better understanding the issues faced by women and the actions needed to address these challenges. She also acknowledged the vital role women play in addressing the pressing issues facing the nation. 
