Report

A joint programme titled 'Cleanliness Drive of Water Body' was conducted by National Service Scheme (NSS) wing, Department of Environmental Science and Eco Club of Govt. Degree college Dooru on 5th June, 2024 under the banner of World Environment Day with the official theme of 'Land Restoration, Desertification and Drought Resilience'. A group of 50 NSS volunteers along with faculty members participated in the environmental awareness and cleanliness drive at Shehlinag, Mirmaidan. This programme is part of a major initiative by the NSS wing of GDC Dooru to sensitize students and general public with regard to maintenance of cleanliness of water bodies including springs and streams of Dooru Shahabad currently showing environmental degradation.

The programme kickstarted from the Govt. Degree College Dooru with the brief introduction by the worthy Principal, Prof. Gh. Hassan Thakur regarding the importance of the World Environment Day. He impressed upon the NSS volunteers and students to take part in various environmental activities initiated by NSS and Eco Club in order to safeguard the vagaries of environment from various anthropogenic pressures. The NSS Officer, Dr. Malik Yasir also highlighted the importance of celebrating



the World Environment Day in the context of current environmental crisis faced by the society. Dr. Malik Yasir also gave brief instructions to be followed while carrying out cleanliness drive at Shehlinag Spring. After the brief introductory session in the college, the participants headed towards the designated water body for cleanliness drive.

After reaching the selected water body, NSS volunteers along with faculty members carried out cleanliness drive. Three student groups, each led by the one faculty member, were formed for smooth conduct of environmental drive. The student volunteers first cleaned the peripheries of the water body by collection of all the plastic waste and dumping them in the dustbins. Thereafter the water body was cleaned by removing all the plastic and other waste debris accumulated in the water. The inlet and outlet of the spring was also cleaned making sure that the movement of the water is smooth. In addition to the practical cleanliness drive, community awareness was also made by sensitising the local population regarding the benefits of maintaining serenity and pristineness of the water body by not allowing people to dumb their waste into the water. The programme ended with the pledge by the NSS volunteers, students and faculty that they will participate in all environmental activities which are aimed to safeguard the environment. The participants were given light refreshment after their return back to the college.
