




Session 1: The programme was kickstarted by the worthy Principal, Prof. Peer Irfan Rashid by giving inaugural address. In his remarks, Prof. Peer Irfan Rashid highlighted the important role played by Dr. B.R. Ambedkar in the making of constitution and pointed out that students should take interest in understanding various tenets of Indian constitution. In the first session, Dr. Mohd Younes Bhat delivered an expert talk titled "The Key Role of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar in India's Constitution-Making Process." At the outset, Dr. Younes highlighted Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's background and emphasized his mission to contribute to the building of a new India through the design of the Indian Constitution. He elaborated on the importance of the Constitution of India for the welfare of its citizens and discussed its philosophical significance by providing various examples. 




Glimpses of Session 1st: An expert lecture delivered by Dr. Younes Bhat






Glimpses of Session 2nd: Preamble Recitation (Pledge Ceremony)


